New Products: TI introduces smart platform for electronic ID

[Texas Instruments Inc.](#), headquartered in Dallas, TX, has recently introduced its RF360, the first smart integrated circuit platform to be developed specifically for the contactless government electronic identification market that includes e-passports, national ID cards and other applications. The RF360 platform will easily scale to meet future capabilities of government IDs such as larger amounts of memory for additional biometrics and multiple application credentials, said Texas Instruments.

CELL VIDEO SURVEILLANCE - Sunnyvale, CA-based [mobiDEOS, Inc.](#) has introduced its 2.0 version of its MobileIPCamViewer, which enables cell phones to view video surveillance images captured from an entire line of network cameras from [Axis Communications](#). The company's viewer is already integrated with major cell phone manufacturers such as Motorola, Nokia, BlackBerry, Sony-Ericsson and others.

SMART CARD PRODUCTION - [On-Track Innovations Ltd.](#), of Rosh Pina, Israel, has introduced its first automated production line for dual interface smart cards that work with both contact and contactless applications. It is designed to support governments issuing secured ID cards. The new production line, based on years of experience at OTI's subsidiary in Shenzhen, China, increases efficiency, speeds up the manufacturing process, saves on manpower and reduces the chance for human error, said OTI.

DESKTOP SWITCHES - [Avocent Corp.](#), of Huntsville, AL, has announced its two new KVM desktop switches which allow users to access data stored on multiple computers -- each operating at different levels of classification -- and enable users to comply with HSPD-12 requirements. The new SwitchView SC 200 series switches are among the industry's first secure KVM switches to be approved by the National Information Assurance Partnership (NIAP).
